After service Lunch at Cannich, June 29th 2008



The rearrangement of Sunday worship, "Up the glens", to change from strictly alternate Sundays at Cannich and Struy to Cannich every 1st and 3rd Sunday with Struy every 2nd and 4th Sunday has introduced the phenomenon of, "5th Sundays". This means that 4 times a year a month contains 5 Sundays and the Church has taken advantage of this to introduce 4 services per year where all the members of the congregation unite to worship together in one church building.

The opportunity arose for the members of the congregation to engage in conversation and conviviality. The idea of a "wee cup of tea", was extended to a pleasant lunch.

The first occasion arose on Sunday March 30th in Beauly and around 80 good souls enjoyed a fine spread in the Church Hall after the morning worship.

Sunday June 29th was the next "5th" and nearly 70 folks from Beauly swelled the usual congregation in Cannich and enjoyed a very fine picnic sitting around the Church in the sunshine, (without midges), after a service appropriately based on "The Feeding of the 5,000"
